Under the theme “Artificial Intelligence for a Better Future,” the Global Research Conference Shusha 2025 brought together distinguished representatives from academia, science, technology, and industry from Azerbaijan and around the world.

The plenary opening ceremony was held in Shusha, with the participation of faculty from the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, researchers from the Institute of Physics of the National Academy of Sciences (AMEA), the leadership and academic staff of Karabakh University, as well as representatives from Azerbaijan State Pedagogical University, Baku Business University, the Institute of Agrarian Problems, and Ganja State University.

International participants included representatives from the Singapore University of Technology and Design, the founder of the Singapore-based Artificial Intelligence International Institute (AIII), professors from Recep Tayyip Erdoğan University and Bitlis Eren University (Turkey), an AI expert from Innevic (Canada), representatives from KOBIA, the founder of Automatica, and experts from various organizations in the fields of science, education, and industry.

Continuing the plenary activities, a virtual scientific session was held on June 21, where authors presented their papers included in the official conference proceedings.

More than 50 research papers on various applications of Artificial Intelligence were accepted for publication in the international scientific journal SSJ – Shusha Scientific Journal.

Participants took part in a cultural and ecological excursion to Shusha and Lachin, allowing them to explore the nature and history of the liberated Karabakh region.

A formal visit to Karabakh University in Khankendi was also held, with fruitful meetings with the academic staff and preliminary agreements for future academic collaboration.

As a result of the conference, the “Shusha Declaration” was adopted. The declaration outlines strategic calls for ethical, inclusive, and sustainable development of intelligence across disciplines.

During the event, the launch of the Shusha Global Intelligences Institute (SIII) was also announced. SIII is envisioned as an interdisciplinary doctoral and research platform bringing together human, artificial, emotional, cultural, and ethical intelligences under one academic roof.

The conference was initiated and organized by MIE Azerbaijan (MetaWay) LLC.
